- The branch of Christian theology relating to the person, nature, and role of Christ.
- The person of Christ- How is Jesus fully God and fully man, yet one person?
- The Atonement - Was it necessary for Christ to die? Did Christ's entire earthly life earn any saving benefit for us? The cause and the nature of the atonement. Did Christ descent into hell?
- Resurrection and Ascension

Doctrine of Christ- Christology

Key Statement

Jesus was fully God and fully man in one person, and will be so forever.

The Humanity of Christ

Main Points

- Virgin Birth - Mathew 1:18,20, 24-25; Luke 1:35; 3:23
 - Salvation must come from the Lord
 - Genesis 3:15
 - Gal. 4:4-5
 - Virgin birth made possible the uniting of full deity and full humanity in one person (John 3:16)
 - Gal. 4:4
 - It made possible Christ's true humanity without inherited sin. (Luke 1:35)
 - This is the reason for Roman Catholic church say Mary was without sin.

Human Weakness and Limitations

Some Facts

- Jesus had a human body (Luke 2:7, 40, 52; John 19:28 - I thirst)
- Jesus Had a Human Mind (Luke 2:52 - increased in wisdom; Mark 13:32 - no one knows)
- Jesus Had a Human Soul and Human Emotions (John 12:27; 13:21 John 11:35)
- People near Jesus Saw Him only as a man (Mathew 13:53-58)

The Deity of Christ

Main Points

- Jesus was not only fully Human abut also fully divine.
- Incarnation- Jesus was God in human flesh.
- The word God(Theos) used of Christ (John1:1, 18)
- The word Lord (Kyrios) used of Christ (1 Cor. 8:6)

The Deity of Christ

The word God(Theos) used of Christ (John 1:1, 18)

- Theos is mainly used for God the Father in NT but there are several passages where it is also used to refer to Jesus Christ.
- It refers to the Creator of heaven and earth and who rules over it.
- John 1:1 1:18; 20:28
- Romans 9:5
- Titus 2:13
- Hebrews 1:8
- 2 Peter 1:1
- Isaiah 9:6

The word Lord (Kyrios) used of Christ (1 Cor. 8:6)

- Word is used for Lord or Master
